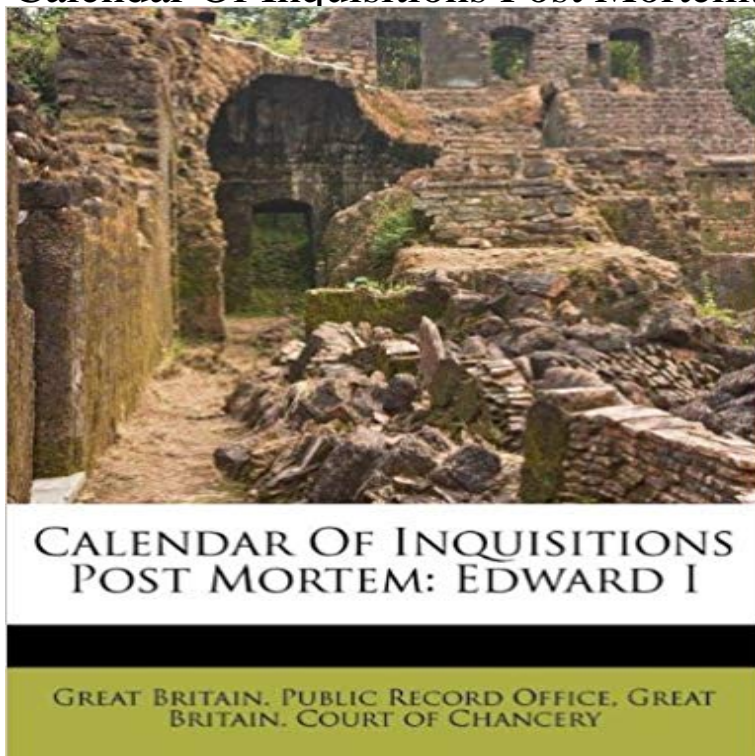


## Calendar Of Inquisitions Post Mortem: Edward I
